Create a new padlet - 1

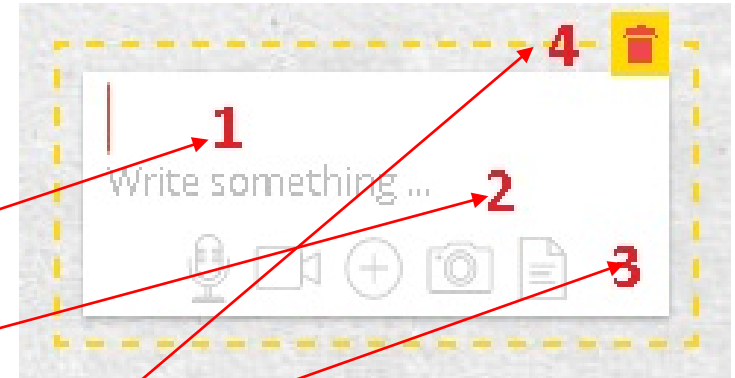


1. Click "New Padlet"



Create a design - 2

- Left double click anywhere you want to post or drag and drop any file you want to share from your computer.



1. Write your post title
2. Describe your post
3. Click there to attach any file you want
4. Click there to delete the post



Add An Attachment

1. Click there to paste any link you want to share
2. Click there to upload any file you want to share
3. Click there to take photo from your computer

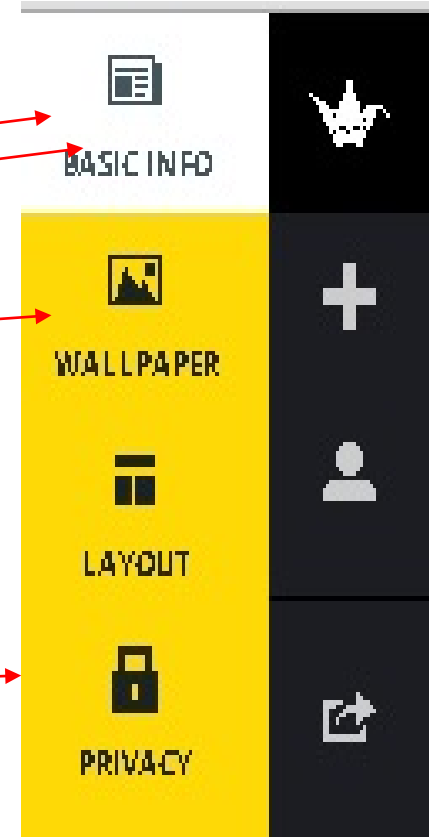
Add an attachment

Paste link to a website, webpage, photo, video, song, document, article, another padlet, or anything else.

Modify Padlet






1. Click the Gear on your right
2. Click "Basic Info" to insert your Padlet Image, Title and Description
3. Click "Wallpaper" to change your background image
4. Click "Layout" to change how the posts will appear on your Padlet
5. Click "Privacy" to change who can see your Padlet




Share Your Padlet





1. Click 
2. Select the Way You Want to Share your Padlet
3. Click on "Export" if you want to transfer your Padlet to any file type like PDF or Image.
