Imagination Is More Important Than Knowledge...

Digipro started the development and usage of the FUNecole® curriculum 15 years ago. FUNecole® deployment by external schools started with <u>INSPIRE ICT</u> project (2008-2010). INSPIRE ICT was a Transfer of Innovation (TOI) European Funded project coordinated by Digipro that facilitated teachers' personal digital skills development, and promoted the usage of ICT in teaching and learning. Digipro with FUNecole®, is a partner on the <u>Open Discovery Space (ODS)</u> project. ODS is a large scale European Project (with total cost €15.32m) that aims to boost the adoption of eLearning resources in schools.

FUNecole® is adopted by European schools and is currently translated into 5 languages. Furthermore, Digipro's teacher development workshops are funded by Erasmus+ programme. Erasmus+ aims to support actions in the fields of Education, Training, Youth and Sport, for the period 2014-2020. A Transdisciplinary FUNecole® Lesson.

Light My Fire. The Power Of Love:

This lesson is from the first Green Awareness Year.

The aim of the lesson is to motivate 6-year-old students to share their feelings, knowledge and material things.

Mr Attitude[™] (the teacher) comes into class with a candle. Using his candle flame he lights the candles of Systematic[™] and Click[™] (the students). Mr Attitude's candle flame is still allowing as before, despite sharing it!

After watching this video, all students participate in a class discussion. They answer questions like: "What does the flame represent?", "Is Mr Attitudes' flame diminished after sharing it?", "What are the results of having more beaming candles in the room?".

Students, in groups, talk about sharing. Sharing is not about a loss or abandonment... sharing is about making someone happy... sharing a secret or a concern which might make one feel better. Students use ICT tools to present their thoughts, feelings and opinions.

They produce small essays, stories, presentations, graphics and charts about the merits of sharing. Students are proud of their work. They print and paste it in their portfolios, and upload it to the FUNecole® Learning and Sharing website.
