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


## Jordan's education vision

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### Strategy 1: Blended learning pedagogy

Professional Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Adopt or modify "UNESCO ICT Teacher Competency Standards"</li><li>• Develop blended learning training materials</li></ul>
Pedagogy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Train teachers, principals, &amp; staff in blended learning pedagogy</li><li>• Support implementation in classrooms</li></ul>
Curriculum & Content	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ensure all curriculum digitized on LMS</li><li>• ICT embedded in the curriculum</li><li>• Teacher-developed blended learning lesson plans, content, and educational software / games</li></ul>
Assessment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Support implementation of blended learning assessment in classrooms</li></ul>
ICT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All teachers have easy, daily access to ICT in classroom</li><li>• All schools develop local ICT plans.</li></ul>
